Closing Celebration: On Friday afternoon, our closing celebration will offer an opportunity for children to share what they've learned with their families, so you can connect with them and their experiences.

How much does Peace Camp cost? Peace Camp is funded through generous donations of time and money from our congregation here at Mt. Tam United Methodist Church. We ask families to contribute \$197 per child to help cover some of the costs and also to provide 3 hours of parent volunteer time per family. We designate two three hour sessions each day of camp where parents are able to assist leaders and participate with their kids. If you are unable to volunteer during camp days, there are other opportunities to support the camp – please ask!

Who participates in Peace Camp? Peace Camp is open to children ages 5-12. Children of all religious/spiritual traditions or none are encouraged to participate. Registrations are accepted on a first-come, first-served basis. Please submit your registration forms and payment early.

Who are the leaders? Representatives from Mt. Tam United Methodist Church and volunteers from other faith traditions will be participating as leaders. In addition, skilled adults with special expertise, such as yoga teachers, artists, musicians and educators, are hired to lead various classes. High school and college youth may serve as camp counselors and will stay with the children throughout the day.

What will the children learn at Peace Camp? Children will learn about peacemaking through storytelling, faith practices and traditions, yoga, the arts (music/dance/visual arts), non-competitive games and movement, nature and through learning peaceful conflict resolution and communication skills. We cover themes such as self-acceptance, empathy and compassion, cooperation, generosity, sharing, and respect. All activities will be age appropriate and will model deep respect for cultural and religious diversity.

What about lunch and snacks? Children will bring their own lunches each day. Healthy morning and afternoon snacks will be provided.
